Osteoporosis:

Designing an Effective Non-Drug Treatment Program

Chiropractors regularly encounter patients looking for more natural care for osteoporosis. As we are seen as "natural doctors" that is fitting but it is a serious responsibility. These patients are often aware and skeptical of the antiresorptive drug treatments as they are associated with significant adverse effects. The most common adverse effects include acid reflux, nausea, and diarrhea or constipation. The chronic esophageal irritation has been associated with a small but significant number of cases of esophageal cancer. More serious adverse effects include atypical transverse long bone fractures and osteonecrosis of the jaw.

These patient inquiries are increasing the result of demographic shift. The U.S. population as well as that of the developed world broadly is aging. The U.S. population grew 28% from 1985 to 2000. This growth was not evenly distributed between all age groups. The 45 and up population grew 2 ½ times greater than that under 45 years. It is projected that the population >65 years will exceed that of the 29 and under population by 2050 (1).

A natural outcome of this demographic shift is a population that has growing numbers of age-related diseases. One of those diseases is osteoporosis. Approximately 20% of the adult population have the disease while more than 1 in 4 women over 64 years have it. Equally alarming is the fact that more than 50% of women >64 years have osteopenia which is essentially early osteoporosis.

Osteoporosis is defined as a T score, or the number of standard deviations below that of young adults, of -2.5 or greater. Osteopenia is defined as a T score between -1.0 and -2.5. The concern with osteoporosis is fragility fracture which is a fracture from either no stress other than weight bearing or from less force than would be needed to fracture healthy bone. Osteoporosis increases fracture risk approximately 70% compared to that in healthy bone. Osteopenia is not benign and increases the risk 31% compared to healthy bone.

The common non-drug treatment recommendations rarely result in meaningful improvement. These recommendations typically include ongoing weightbearing exercise

and adequate intake of minerals, vitamin D and vitamin K2. These interventions have utility in prevention in early to midlife to prevent bone loss but have questionable clinical effect once disease is present. The vast majority of patients presenting with osteoporosis are already taking these nutrients yet subsequent DEXA scans demonstrate progression.

The primary driver of age-related bone loss is an imbalanced activity between osteoclasts and osteoblasts/osteocytes. Simply supplying those materials without restoring normal cell activity has minimal impact on bone density. Studies have shown that supplementation of these nutrients can make a statistically significant change in bone density, but there is doubt that this change is clinically meaningful. A 2020 study found that this supplementation improved bone density 1%. While the research analysis showed that this was statistically significant or occurred fairly uniformly, it is not clinically meaningful in terms of fracture risk reduction. (2, 3)

Bone is constantly remodeling to repair microdamage and to handle changed weight bearing stress. This process is orchestrated by osteocytes (OST). They make up 90% of bone cells and are distributed throughout bone matrix interconnecting by multiple dendrites. Osteocytes serve as "mechanoreceptors" sensing bone load by electric signals generated by the sliding of matrix collagen fibers. This is similar to static that occurs sliding feet across carpet or other surfaces.

Continued from page 3 This electric signal activates the remodeling process with osteoclasts

activating to remove micro-damaged bone. This is quickly followed by activation of osteoblasts which fill in new bone. Remodeling replaces 10% of our bone yearly and the entire skeleton is replaced every decade. Bone density peaks between 30 and 40 years of age and then declines 1-2% per year after the age of 40 equating to a typical loss of 15-20% by age 55 years. At that point hormone decline, particularly of estrogen, accelerates loss to 3-5% in women and 2% in men.


The progressive decline in bone density is driven by an increased activation of osteoclasts combined with diminished numbers and activity of osteoblasts. Considerable research has elucidated these shifts in cell balance. Osteoclasts are activated by an inflammatory signal from osteocytes called receptor activator of NFκB ligand (RANKL) which activates the NFκB pathway involved in all inflammatory signaling.


Extensive research has shown that there is progressive inflammatory signaling in humans with aging. Immunologists have coined the term "inflammaging" to describe this phenomenon. Systemic causes of inflammatory signaling such as gut dysbiosis and joint degeneration can tap into osteoclasts by their toll like receptors exaggerating the controlled inflammatory signaling typical of normal bone remodeling.


Agut restoration program to resolve dysbiosis and anti-inflammatory therapy with omega-3 FAs, curcumin and other herbs is important

to diminish osteoclastic activity. This is not only helpful in bone but also all others systems affected by inflammation such as joints.

Continued from page 5 Bisphosphonates which are the first line drugs in osteoporosis treatment, inhibit osteoclast signaling diminishing bone

removal but they do not improve osteoblast and osteocytes activity in ongoing bone regeneration. This lack of effect on osteoblastic activity is thought to be a mechanism associated with their adverse bone effects in some cases.

Osteoblasts have a life cycle of between 10-100 days. They must be constantly replenished by mesenchymal stem cells which migrate from yellow bone marrow in long bones.

Unfortunately, mesenchymal stem cell populations in yellow bone marrow diminish with age accounting for the reduced bone osteoblastic activity. The electromagnetic signal discussed above initiates mesenchymal stem cell migration to bone for conversion to osteoblasts.

The electromagnetic signal that normally is generated in healthy bone causing osteoblasts numbers to increase can be "bio-hacked" by different forms of energy signals increasing bone regeneration. While weight bearing exercise and whole-body vibration can do this to some degree, much greater effect can be generated by laser therapy or by PEMF therapy.

The typical improvement in bone mineral density (BMD) with bisphosphonate treatment is 5-8% over 1-3 years. Laser therapy has been shown to increase BMD 16-18% when applied 3 times per week for 3 months ⁽⁴⁾. PEMF therapy activates several differentiation and proliferation pathways in mesenchymal stem cells significantly replenishing osteoblast cell numbers and activity. Trials have shown PEMF therapy 3 times per week for 3 months produced 26-39% increased BMD ^(4, 5, 6).

Laser therapy needs to deliver 4-6 J/cm2 to the target bone including the lumbar spine and hips so it is important to have

a good laser with enough power to do that efficiently. It is also important to treat an area of bone containing yellow marrow such as the shaft of a long bone where mesenchymal stem cells reside. This has been shown to increase migration and differentiation of stem cell to osteoblasts. The medial tibial surface is relatively superficial and an ideal location for this purpose.

PEMF therapy is perhaps the optimal energy therapy for osteoporosis as it is less time dependent on the therapist and has shown the greatest improvements in bone density. A unit with multiple solenoids is ideal so they can be placed in the areas mentioned above about laser application simultaneously. The trials showing these significant gains have used 40-50 Hz at 40 gauss PEMF signal.

Osteoporosis is a complex process. We owe it to our patients to understand the process and how to best help it. Effective non-drug therapy can produce important gains in bone density, an outcome our patients are asking for. Our profession is perhaps the best positioned to fill this need.
